The day starts at 9.45am at the car park at King George's Playing Field café area for those that need transportation to site, and ends at approximately 3pm. Please bring a packed lunch and make sure you wear clothes suitable for the weather conditions, which includes safety boots.

Date:	19 July 2017
Location:	Hatch Road Country Park, Brentwood to include Green Lane public footpath
Parking:	Bishops Hall Park, Brentwood
Scheduled Works:	Continue with the project to lift the vegetation and tree lines along the ditch lines which run along the country park. Clear vegetation from the public footpath running adjacent to Bishops Hall Park.
Date:	26 July 2017
Location:	Warley Country Park
Parking:	Warley Country Park
Scheduled Works:	Cutting back vegetation from footways and cycle ways throughout the park.
Date:	2 August 2017
Location:	Lascelles Close, Pilgrims Hatch
Parking:	Lascelles Close, Pilgrims Hatch
Scheduled Works:	Removing dumped material along the footpath running to the rear of Lascelles Close. Cutting back vegetation from the Lascelles footpath as well as Crow Green Lane footpath.
Date:	9 August 2017
Location:	Clements Park, Warley
Parking:	Pastorial Way, Clements Park, Warley
Scheduled Works:	Removing lower vegetation along the boundary fence with Warley Hill and the baseball field at Clements Park/Hollywood to ensure a clear view across the site. General litter pick of site including woodland.
