- 4. The Council particularly welcomes any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to comment on the Council's proposals, or the recommendations of the Acting Returning Officer.
- 5. The Council's proposals for polling districts and polling places to be used at local and national elections will be published on 8th September 2023 and all comments must be received by the consultation closing date on 23rd October 2023.
